Entries are now being accepted for the 2012 Rotary Art Exhibition to be held in the Clare Town Hall from 19 to 24 of May 2012. This is the fifteenth exhibition and follows on from the success of last year where 65 paintings were sold, for a value of \$21,369.

Entry forms are enclosed and these must be in by Friday April 20 April, 2012. It is suggested you register early as there is a limit of 550 entries, the capacity of the Clare Town Hall. This year, the prize money totals \$14,800. There are several changes to the categories with two sculpture sections, indoor and outdoor. We have also discontinued the "other" category which covered various mediums such as photography.

The exhibition will open on Friday 18 May and coincides with the Clare Valley Gourmet Weekend on 19 / 20 of May. Many visitors take time to enjoy Clare Valley wines and our exhibition over this weekend. Tickets for the Gala Opening are \$15 and available from the Clare Visitors Centre or Stringybark Country Clothing in the main street of Clare.

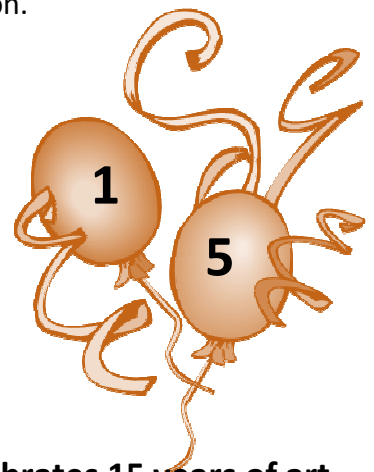
