



# The CLARE ROTARY ART EXHIBITION 2012

## CONDITIONS of ENTRY, SALE of ARTWORKS, & INFORMATION TO ENTRANTS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Exhibition is open to all artists.

- Youth Section must be aged 18 years or less on 1/5/12
- Junior Section must be aged 12 years or less on 1/5/12

### JUDGE(S):

- Shall be such person or persons selected by the organization.
- If the judge does not award a prize in any category the prize monies shall be carried forward to the next Exhibition held by The Rotary Club of Clare Inc.
- The decision of the Judge(s) is final.

### NUMBER OF ENTRIES:

- A maximum of three (3) exhibits per artist.
- All paintings entered as pairs or triplets are counted as individual paintings.
- Due to the size of the display area a maximum of 550 entries will be accepted – submit your entry early

### PRIZES:

- No exhibit may be awarded more than one prize, apart from the "People's Choice" prize.
- The winner of any acquisitive prizes will receive the full amount of prize money. Please consider the amount of the prize money in comparison to the sale price of the painting when filling out your entry form.
- Entries awarded acquisitive prize become the property of the business/organisation donating the prize.

### EXHIBIT REQUIREMENTS:

Paintings (2D art) and Sculptures (3D art) must:

- be the original work of the artist,
- be in permanent media,
- have been executed within two years of May 2012
- not exceed a maximum size, including frame, of 1.0 square metres (paintings over this size will rate as two entries),
- artworks must be suitably FRAMED or MOUNTED FOR HANGING, using picture wire only,
- Youth and Junior entries need not be framed but must have sound provision for hanging.

Sculptures exceeding 80kg in weight and 1.2 cubic metres in volume require pre-show approval.

The Clare Valley - the purposes of this Exhibition, works entered in this category should depict any aspect of the environment, industry or culture of the Clare Valley as defined by the boundaries of the Clare and Gilbert Valley's Council.

### SUBMITTING ENTRY(S):


**SECTION A of the Entry Form** must be completed in full, signed and lodged by each artist with the appropriate entry fee. Entry Fees: Adult (18 or over on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2010) \$10 per entry; Youth \$5 and Junior \$3 per entry.

**Closing date for Entry Forms is FRIDAY 20 April 2012**

**SECTION B of the Entry Form** must be attached to the back of each exhibit, with the required details completed.

### DURATION OF EXHIBITION:

- All exhibits will remain on view whether sold or not, until the close of the Exhibition at 5pm on Thursday 24 May, 2012.

### DELIVERY OF ART:

- Deliveries must be free of charge, to the Clare Town Hall Function Room, Main North Road, Clare, on **Tuesday 15 May (9am - 6pm) and Wednesday 16 May (9am - 11am)**
- Late delivery of exhibits cannot be accepted.
- Exhibits must be packaged appropriately.

### COLLECTION OF ART:

- Collected from Clare Town Hall on **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May (9am - 4pm)**
- **Art not collected by 4pm of that date, or at the Adelaide collection time, will be returned to the artist cash on deliver (COD) to the address that has been provided on the entry form.**

### PRICE OF ART:

- **All entries must be for sale** at the price indicated on the Entry Form.
- The price of an entry cannot be altered once it has been received.
- Price on application (POA) will not be accepted on any art.

### ORGANISER'S COMMISSION:

- In the event of a sale, The Rotary Club of Clare will charge a commission of twenty five percent (25%) to be used for community projects.
- Exhibits sold will carry a red sticker. Artists should check with the sales desk to confirm that the sticker has been correctly affixed. No responsibility can be accepted for stickers affixed in error.

### ORGANISER'S RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:

- The Rotary Club of Clare reserves the right to reject any entry, to limit the number of exhibits on display, and to not award a prize in a particular section if the Judge(s) considers that no work of sufficient merit has been entered.
- For the proper and orderly conduct of the Exhibition, the Rotary Club of Clare also reserves the right, in its sole discretion, at any time and without prior notice to amend, alter or vary any of the conditions of the entry or to do any other thing which it deems fit.
- The Rotary Club of Clare reserves the right to publish the artists name (but not the artists address or other personal information) and a photograph of any entries in the exhibition catalogue, artist's newsletter, newspaper and the Rotary Club of Clare Web site and Facebook pages.

### RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE:

All reasonable care will be exercised in the handling of submitted works. However, no responsibility will be accepted by the RC of Clare for the loss or damage of any works or packaging while in transit to or from the Exhibition or while in the custody of the organisers or their agents.

**The provision of suitable insurance cover is the responsibility of the artist for the transport of exhibits to and from the exhibition and for the duration of the Exhibition.**
