

## **Conditions of Entry- The Rotary Club of Clare Inc. 2010 Art Exhibition**

1. **Eligibility.** The Art Exhibition is open to all artists.  
**Youth Section** artists must be aged 18 years or less on 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2010.  
**Junior Section** artists must be aged 12 years or less on 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2010.
2. **Judge or Judges** of the Exhibition shall be such person or persons selected by the organisers and will inspect all entries. If the judge does not award a prize in any category the prize monies shall be carried forward to the next Exhibition held by The Rotary Club of Clare Inc. The decisions of the Judge(s) are final.
3. **Number of Entries.** Each artist may enter a maximum of three (3) exhibits . Due to the size of the display area a maximum of 550 entries will be accepted. All paintings entered as pairs or triplets are counted as individual paintings. Please submit your entry form early to avoid disappointment
4. **Prizes.** No exhibit may be awarded more than one prize, apart from the “People’s Choice” prize. Acquisitive Prizes have been awarded by various organisations. The winner of an acquisitive prize will receive the full amount of prize money. Please consider the amount of the prize money in comparison to the sale price of the painting when filling out your entry form. Entries awarded an acquisitive prize become the property of the organisation donating the prize.
5. **Exhibit Requirements.** Paintings (2D art work) and Sculptures (3D art work) must:
  - be the original work of the artist,
  - be in permanent media,
  - have been executed within two years of May 2010.Artworks must:
  - not exceed a maximum size, including frame, of 1.0 square metres (paintings over this size will rate as two entries), and,
  - be fitted with sound hanging fixings, dry and ready for hanging. (Youth and Junior entries need not be framed but must have sound provision for hanging)

Sculptures exceeding 80kg in weight and 1.2 cubic metres in volume require pre-show approval.

The Clare Valley For the purposes of this Exhibition, works entered in this category should depict any aspect of the environment, industry or culture of the Clare Valley as defined by the boundaries of the Clare and Gilbert Valley’s Council.

### **6 Entry Conditions:**

- 6.1 **SECTION A of the Entry Form.** Section A must be completed in full, signed and lodged by each artist with the appropriate entry fee. Entry Fees: Adult (18 or over on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2010) \$12 for the first and \$6 each for the second and third exhibits. Youth and Junior: \$3 each entry.

**Closing date for Entry Forms is Thursday 22nd April 2010**

- 6.2 **SECTION B of the Entry Form.** Section B must be attached to the back of each exhibit, with the required details completed.
- 6.3.1 **Delivery of Exhibits.** Deliveries must be free of charge, to the Clare Town Hall Function Room, Main North Road, Clare, on Tuesday 11 May (9am - 6pm) and Wednesday 12 May ( 9am –11am) Late delivery of exhibits cannot be accepted. - 6.4 **Collection of Exhibits** Friday 21 May May (9am-4pm).**Note there is no collection on Thursday**

- 6.5 **Sale Price.** All entries must be for sale at the price indicated on the Entry Form. The price of an entry cannot be altered once it has been received.
- 6.6 **Commission for Sale.** In the event of a sale, The Rotary Club of Clare will charge a commission of twenty five percent (25%) to be used for community and international projects. Exhibits sold will carry a red sticker. Artists should check with the sales desk to confirm that the sticker has been correctly affixed. No responsibility can be accepted for stickers affixed in error.
- 6.7 **Rights Reserved.** The Rotary Club of Clare reserves the right to reject any entry, to limit the number of exhibits on display, and to not award a prize in a particular section if the Judge(s) consider that no work of sufficient merit has been entered.  
For the proper and orderly conduct of the Exhibition, The Rotary Club of Clare also reserves the right, in its sole discretion, at any time and without prior notice to amend, alter or vary any of the conditions of the entry or to do any other thing which it deems fit.  
The Rotary Club of Clare reserves the right to publish the artists name (but not the artists address or other personal information) and a photograph of any entries in the exhibition catalogue, artists newsletter, newspaper and the Rotary Club of Clare web site.
- 6.8 **Responsibility for Loss or Damage.** All reasonable care will be exercised in the handling of submitted works. However, no responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for the loss or damage of any works or packaging while in transit to or from the Exhibition or while in the custody of the organisers or their agents. The provision of suitable insurance cover is the responsibility of the artist for the transport of exhibits to and from the exhibition and for the duration of the Exhibition.
- 6.9 **Duration of Exhibits.** All exhibits on view will remain in the Exhibition, whether sold or not, until the close of the Exhibition at 5pm on Thursday 20 May, 2010.
- 6.10 **Exhibition Opening Times.** The Exhibition is open to the public at the following times:
